Announcer: 500 fish harvesters from around the province will be trained over the next three years to spot and clean up ocean oil spills under programs announced today by One Ocean. One Ocean's Gordy Slade says ACOA has provided near a half million dollars for the training.

Gordy Slade: The Marine Institute's offshore safety and Survival Centre will provide the instructors for the five day institute training and will provide the certificate at the end of that time. The Canadian Coast Guard will supply personnel and existing the equipment throughout the three year term, and has donated the use of their mobile unit and personnel for the program's pilot project on September the 19th in Arnold's Cove.
