

# MARINE ENVIRONMENTAL EMERGENCY OIL SPILL INFORMATION

## **When reporting a spill you may be asked:**

- Vessel name and call sign
- Vessel position
- Time of position
- Type of emergency (oil slick, sheen, oily birds, etc.)
- Time and date observed
- Location of initial spill (latitude, longitude)
- Number of oiled and unoled birds (whether dead or alive) in area and name of species if known
- Sightings of marine mammals in the area and name of species if known
- Size of slick(s)
- Any odours detected
- Name, call sign, description and position of any vessels in area

## **You may be called back for information on:**

- What type of oil deposit if known and colour
- Any oil found on gear or vessel
- Names and contact information of anyone who may have observed the pollution incident

**All environmental incidents must be reported immediately to the nearest Canadian Coast Guard Radio Station.**
